

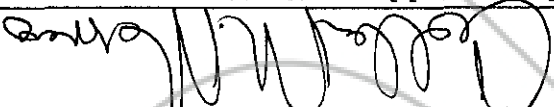
FULL RECONVEYANCE

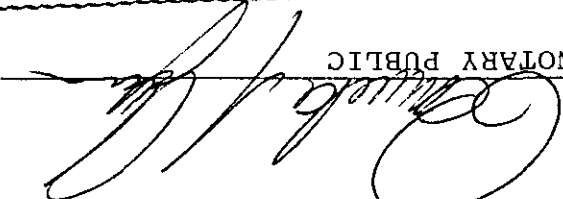

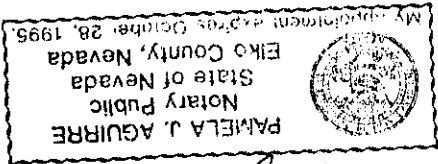
