

QUITCLAIM ASSIGNMENT

THIS QUITCLAIM ASSIGNMENT, dated this 24th day of April, 1995, but effective as of January 1, 1993 (the "Effective Time"), is among APACHE CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation; APC OPERATING PARTNERSHIP, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership (also sometimes known as APC Operating Company); APACHE PETROLEUM PARTNERSHIP 1974-I, LTD., a Minnesota limited partnership; APCO-PROGRAM 1975-II PARTNERSHIP, a Minnesota limited partnership; APCO-PROGRAM 1977-I PARTNERSHIP, a Minnesota limited partnership; APCO-PROGRAM 1977-II PARTNERSHIP, a Minnesota limited partnership; APCO-PROGRAM 1979-II PARTNERSHIP, a Minnesota limited partnership; APCO-PROGRAM 1979-III PARTNERSHIP, a Minnesota limited partnership; APCO-PROGRAM 1979-IV PARTNERSHIP, a Minnesota limited partnership; APACHE PETROLEUM PARTNERSHIP 1980-I, LTD., a Minnesota limited partnership; APCO-PROGRAM 1980-I PARTNERSHIP, a Minnesota limited partnership; APACHE PETROLEUM PARTNERSHIP 1980-II, LTD., a Minnesota limited partnership; APCO-PROGRAM 1980-II PARTNERSHIP, a Minnesota limited partnership; APACHE PETROLEUM PARTNERSHIP 1980-III, LTD., a Minnesota limited partnership; APCO-PROGRAM 1980-III PARTNERSHIP, a Minnesota limited partnership; APCO-PROGRAM 1981-I PARTNERSHIP, a Texas limited partnership; APACHE PETROLEUM PARTNERSHIP 1984-I, LTD., a Delaware limited partnership, all with an address of 2000 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 100, Houston, Texas 77056-4400 (collectively "Assignor") and KEY PRODUCTION COMPANY, INC., a Delaware corporation doing business in the State of Texas as Key Energy of Colorado, Inc. and in the State of South Dakota as Key Production Company of Colorado, Inc., with an office at 1700 Lincoln Street, Suite 2050, Denver, Colorado 80203 ("Assignee") and APACHE CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation with an office at 2000 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 100, Houston, Texas 77056-4400, as the assignee of the Remainder Interests, as defined in Section 2 below.

PREAMBLE TO INSTRUMENT

- A. This instrument consists of two sections. The first section quitclaims a portion of Assignor's interests in certain properties from Assignor to Assignee. The second section quitclaims the remainder of Assignor's interests in those properties to Apache Corporation.
- B. All transfers of interests are made pursuant to the terms and conditions of a Dissolution Agreement and Quitclaim Assignment dated as of January 1, 1993, among Apache Corporation, APC Operating Partnership L.P. and Assignee.
- C. The following is a brief description of the purpose of each Exhibit attached hereto.
- (1) Exhibit A contains a description of non-producing leases, orders, licenses, permits or other documents in which Assignee will acquire a working interest

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- (2) Exhibit B describes the NPI Overrides to which Assignee's interests will not be subject.
- pursuant hereto. To calculate the interest in each lease assigned to Assignee, multiply the "Key Working Interest" (decimal number) by the "Lease Net Acres" for each lease.

QUITCLAIM ASSIGNMENT OF INTERESTS TO ASSIGNEE

SECTION 1

2.1 Quitclaim Assignment. Assignor, in consideration of \$100.00 and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, does hereby quitclaim and assign to Assignee all of the following:

- (a) **Partial Assignment of Undivided Working Interests in Non-Producing Leases.** An undivided interest equal to the "Key Working Interest" multiplied by the "Lease Net Acres" shown for each of the leases, orders, licenses, permits, or other documents described in Exhibit A attached hereto, INSOFAR AND ONLY INSOFAR as they cover and relate to the land (the "Land") described in Exhibit A (the "Leases"); together with a like percentage of all overriding royalty interests, production payments and other payments described in Exhibit A out of or measured by the value of oil and gas production. To calculate the interest in each lease assigned to Assignee, multiply the "Key Working Interest" (decimal number) by the "Lease Net Acres" for each lease.
- (b) **Incidental Rights.** All the property and rights incident to the Lands and the Leases, including, to the extent transferable, all agreements, product purchase and sale contracts, surface leases, gas gathering contracts, salt water disposal leases and wells, processing agreements, compression agreements, equipment leases, permits, gathering lines, rights-of-way, easements, licenses, farmouts and farmins, options, orders, pooling, spacing or consolidation agreements, unit agreements, operating agreements and other agreements relating hereto.
- (c) **Personal Property.** All of the personal property, fixtures, and improvements as of the Effective Time appurtenant to the Leases, or used or obtained in connection with the operation thereof or with the production, treatment, sale or disposal of hydrocarbons or water produced therefrom or attributable thereto.

All of the foregoing are collectively referred to as the "Interests."

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TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the Interests unto Assignee and its successors and assigns forever, subject to the following:

(i) Assignee, from and after the Effective Time, hereby assumes and agrees to perform and be bound by all provisions of the Leases. Assignee shall, at its sole expense, insofar as such expense is attributable to the Interests, comply with all laws, rules, regulations, orders, and ordinances (collectively the "laws") of any governmental authority claiming jurisdiction over the Leases, including, but not limited to, those laws pertaining to the abandonment of wells, the plugging of inactive wells, and the restoration of the surface.

(ii) Assignor does not in any manner warrant the condition, serviceability, or recoverability of any equipment, and personal property hereby conveyed, and Assignee accepts all such property in its present condition.

(iii) **THIS ASSIGNMENT IS MADE WITHOUT REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EXPRESS, IMPLIED, OR STATUTORY, AND WITHOUT RECOURSE, EVEN AS TO THE RETURN OF ANY PURCHASE PRICE OR OTHER CONSIDERATION PAID HEREIN, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, WARRANTIES OF TITLE, THE WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY, OR THE WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.**

(iv) Assignor reserves the right to use as much of the surface of the Leases as may be necessary in the conduct of operations on adjacent lands owned by Assignor as of the date hereof or in those zones, formations, and depths not assigned to Assignee herein, provided such usage shall be exercised in such fashion as not to interfere unreasonably with Assignee's use of or wellbores drilled by Assignor and not through wells conveyed herein) in conducting such operations in the depths, zones, and formations not assigned herein. Assignor reserves the joint right to use any easements and rights-of-way for its operations on the land covered hereby or on other adjacent lands owned by Assignor as of the date hereby, provided such usage shall be exercised in such fashion as not to interfere unreasonably with Assignee's use of or unreasonably cause damage to the Interests, easements and rights-of-way.

(v) This Quitclaim is expressly made and accepted subject to the terms and conditions of a Dissolution Agreement and Quitclaim Assignment dated as of January 1, 1993, among Apache Corporation, APC Operating Partnership L.P., and Assignee. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the provisions of this Quitclaim and such terms and conditions, such terms and conditions shall control. Copies of the Dissolution Agreement and Quitclaim Assignment are retained in the office of Assignor and Assignee.

(vi) Assignor also hereby grants and transfers to Assignee, its successors and assigns, to the extent so transferable, the benefit of and the right to enforce the covenant

and warranties, if any, which Assignor is entitled to enforce with respect to the Interests against Assignor's predecessors in title to the Interests.

(vii) Certain of Assignor's properties (the "NPI Properties") are burdened or encumbered by and subject to (a) those Assignments of Overriding Royalty described on Exhibit "C" hereto (collectively the "NPI Overrides") and (b) by a Loan Agreement dated December 30, 1986, among APC Operating Partnership L.P. ("APCOP"), the State of Wisconsin Investment Board, and Norwest Bank Minneapolis, National Association, as agent, and various security instruments and mortgages executed pursuant thereto (the "State of Wisconsin Financing"). Apache Corporation ("Apache") and APCOP own additional interests in the NPI Properties which are neither burdened nor encumbered by and are not subject to the NPI Overrides or the State of Wisconsin Financing (the "Unencumbered Interests"). The Interests in the NPI Properties assigned to Assignee pursuant to this Quitclaim shall be assigned by APCOP and Apache from the Unencumbered Interests and Assignee shall take its Interests free and clear of all burdens or encumbrances created pursuant to the NPI Overrides and the State of Wisconsin Financing.

(viii) Unless provided otherwise, all recording references in the Exhibits hereto are to the official real property records of the jurisdiction in which the Interests are located.

(ix) Separate assignments of the Interests may be executed on officially approved forms by Assignor to Assignee, in sufficient counterparts to satisfy applicable statutory and regulatory requirements. Those assignments shall be deemed to contain all of the exceptions, reservations, rights to enforce covenants and warranties (if any) against Assignor's predecessors in title, rights, titles, power, and privilege set forth herein as fully as though they were set forth in each such assignment. The interests conveyed by such separate assignments are the same and not in addition to the Interests conveyed herein.

(x) This Quitclaim may be executed in any number of counterparts, and each counterpart hereof shall be deemed to be an original instrument, but all such counterparts shall constitute but one assignment. To facilitate recording, a counterpart to be recorded in a given county or parish may contain only those portions of the Exhibits hereto that describes property located in that county or parish. Assignor and Assignee have each retained a counterpart of this Quitclaim with a complete set of Exhibits.

SECTION 2

QUITCLAIM ASSIGNMENT TO APACHE CORPORATION

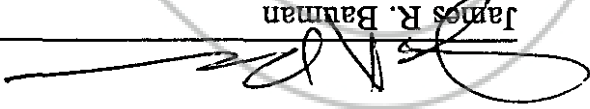
2.1 Quitclaim Assignment; Remainder to Apache Corporation. Assignor, in consideration of \$100.00 and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged by Assignor, does hereby quitclaim and assign

to Apache Corporation any remaining interest it may have in the Interests subsequent to the
quitclaim assignments and bills of sale made in Sections 1 of this Quitclaim (the "Remainder
Interests"), it being the intent of Assignor (other than Apache Corporation) to completely
divest itself of all interests in the Interests.

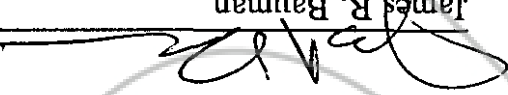
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the Remainder Interests unto Apache Corporation and its

subparagraph to Assignee shall be deemed to be references to Apache Corporation and the
references to Interests shall be deemed to be references to Remainder Interests.

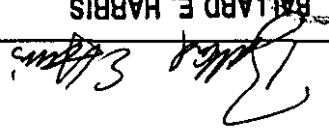
