MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

STATEMENT OF FACTS

12 This action was commenced by Plaintiff on April 9, 1991,
13 as a diversity action pursuant to 28 USC 1332(a). On May 24,
14 1994, the jury in this case entered its verdict in favor of
15 Plaintiff, Jeffrey Tomas and against Defendant, Bullion
16 Monarch Company for total damages at \$6,500. The Honorable
17 David W. Hagen dismissed Defendants' Counterclaims on May 24,
18 1994, pursuant to FRCP Rule 50. The Plaintiff commenced this
19 action against the Defendants seeking damages for breach of
20 contract and fraud.

ARGUMENT

22 In diversity litigation the Federal Courts apply state
23 law with regard to allowance of attorneys' fees. Nevada
24 Revised Statute (NRS) 18.010 provides for compensation of an
25 attorney for his services were an allowance is authorized by
26 specific statute.

1 Such an allowance is authorized in NRS 18.010. The
2 Court may make an allowance of attorneys' fees to a
3 prevailing party, pursuant to NRS 18.010:

4 (a) When he has not recovered more than
5 \$20,000; or,

6 (b) Without regard to recovery sought, where
7 the Court finds that the claim was
8 brought without reasonable ground or to
9 harass the prevailing party.

10 Plaintiff brought this action on April 9, 1991.
11 Plaintiff served Defendant, Don Morris with the Summons and
12 Complaint on April 9, 1991. Plaintiff obtained a Default on
13 September 23, 1991, and Default Judgment on October 30, 1991.
14 Defendants did not file a motion to set aside the default
15 until August 4, 1992. Responding to that motion and
16 preparing for the hearing that ensued increased Plaintiff's
17 fees, cost and expenses considerably. This Court set aside
18 the Default Judgment. Defendants then filed their Answer and
19 Counterclaim on March 1, 1993. Defendants and each of them,
20 demanded a jury trial on March 1, 1993.

21 This Court on May 24, 1994, pursuant to Plaintiff's FRCP
22 Rule 50 Motion for Judgment as a matter of law in actions
23 tried by jury, found no sufficient evidentiary bases for a
24 reasonable jury to find for counterclaimants on their claims
25 of slander of title and intentional interference with
26 prospective advantage. This Court determined those issues
27 against counterclaimants granting Plaintiff's Rule 50 motion
28 that said counterclaims cannot be maintained under

1 controlling law.

2 As more fully appears from the Affidavit of E. SUE

3 SAUNDERS, ESQ., filed herewith, and more specifically

4 summarized with the attached Exhibits "A" and "B", billing

5 statements from attorneys E. SUE SAUNDERS and RICHARD W.

6 HARRIS to Mr. Lomas, respectively, and the Default Judgment

7 entered prior to Saunders appearance in the case. Present

8 counsel incurred \$4,073.68 in costs and \$27,976.00 in

9 attorney's fees. Prior counsel Lynn Pierce and Waldo De

10 Castroverde incurred fees of \$3,962.50 and costs of \$271.96

11 plus interest at a rate of 10.5% since October 30, 1991. See

12 Affidavit "D" and "E" attached hereto. Plaintiff incurred

13 the following costs and attorneys' fees in the defense of

14 this matter:

15 Costs and Disbursements \$ 4,345.64

16 Attorneys' Fees \$31,938.50

17 The attorneys' fees and costs incurred by Plaintiff in

18 the prosecution of his complaint and his defense against

19 Defendants/Counterclaimant's Counterclaim of this matter are

20 reasonable and justified in amount.

21 Fees and expenses were incurred in research, in the

22 discovery process, in preparation of pleadings, jury

23 questions and jury instructions and other documents, as well

24 as in preparation for and attendance at trial. Defendants

25 demanded the jury trial which increased Plaintiff's costs,

26 fees and expenses.

1 This Court is empowered with the discretion to make an
2 award of attorneys' fees in favor of Plaintiff as the
3 prevailing party, pursuant to NRS 18.010.

4 CONCLUSION

5 The instant matter was commenced by Plaintiff against
6 Defendants in a diversity action seeking damages for breach
7 of contract and fraud. The jury entered its verdict for
8 Plaintiff and against Defendant, Bullion Monarch Company in
9 the amount of \$6,500.00.

10 It was established at trial by the Honorable David W.
11 Hagen that there was no basis for Defendants' claims of
12 slander of title or intentional interference with prospective
13 economic advantage. The attorneys' fees and costs incurred
14 by Plaintiff in prosecuting his complaint and defending
15 against Defendants counterclaims, and requested by this
16 Motion, are justified and reasonable.

17 It is respectfully submitted that based upon the matters
18 discussed above, that an award of costs and attorneys' fees
19 in the amounts requested by Plaintiff would be appropriate
20 and reasonable.

21 It is, therefore, respectfully requested that this Court
22 enter its judgment awarding costs and attorneys' fees to
23 Plaintiff against Defendant, Bullion Monarch Company in the
