**EX-PARTE ORDER EXTENDING THE
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**

This matter came before the Court on the ex-parte motion of Elizabeth Kolikoski, Guardian of the Adult Ward, SHARON GIBELLINI. Having reviewed the original ex-parte motion, together with this motion for extension with its supporting exhibits, this Court finds that good cause exists to show that irreparable injury may occur to the ward's estate if the requested injunction is not issued. The injury that would occur is that property belonging to, or that at one time belonged, or that may eventually be found to properly belong to the Ward has already been transferred. The injury would be irreparable because if the transfers of said property, or possible proceeds of said property are not stopped, these assets could be forever lost to the Ward's estate through transfers or sale. Further, this Court has already heard evidence that the Ward may have been incompetent at the time the Ward transferred certain deeds of real property to Janelle Dietrich.

This Order is entered without notice first being made to the necessary parties because service has been attempted upon all parties by mail. Further, it appears to the Court that Janelle Dietrich has been unavailable for personal service. Upon representation of counsel, Jacqualeene Campbell resides out of state and attempts are currently being made to serve her personally. In addition, the Court wishes to preserve and protect the relevant from further transfers that could dissolve any chance to recover property for the Ward.

Good cause exists for this extension because the Court is unable to hear this matter until June

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25, 1998, and also because attempts to personally serve the necessary parties continue.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Guardian's Ex-Parte Motion to Extend the Temporary Restraining Order is granted and that all the provisions of the "Ex-Parte Emergency Order" entered on May 27, 1998, a copy of which is attached, shall continue until the Court hears this matter on June 25, 1998, at 10:00 a.m.

EX-PARTE EMERGENCY ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Janelle Dietrich is enjoined and restrained from the following actions:

1. Transferring any assets now belonging to Janelle Dietrich, including any real or personal property until such time as the Court determines the source of those assets and whether the Ward has an interest in them; *Janelle Dietrich may spend financial resources for reasonable and ordinary living expenses.*
2. Transferring any mining claims, vehicles, tools, banking accounts, business interests or other assets, real estate or personal property in the name of Janelle Dietrich, Sharon Gibellini, or Louis Gibellini, or that have at any time bene in he names of or belonged to Louis Gibellini or Sharon Gibellini.
3. Prohibiting any further move of the property now located in Roy, Utah, or any other place where Janelle Dietrich has taken property from her Eureka County residence.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an in rem injunction protecting assets shall prevent the following actions:

1. Freezing all assets of Janelle Dietrich, including but not limited to accounts at financial institutions, real estate, certificates of deposit, stocks, bonds, mining

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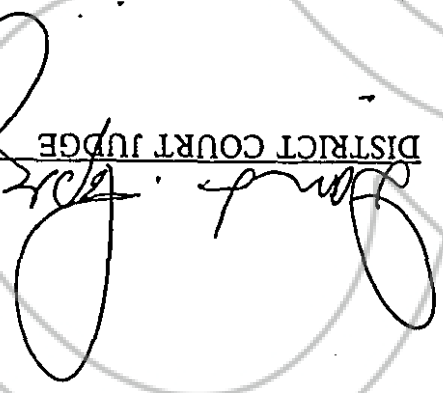
claims, or business accounts, until such time as this Court can determine the source of those assets and whether the Ward has an interest in them.

2. Freezing any further transfers of property, real or persona, currently in the name of Jacqualeen Campbell, which at any time belonged to Louis Gibellini or Sharon Gibellini, until such time as this Court determines the source of those assets and whether the Ward has any interest in them.

3. Freezing any further transfers of property transferred from Janelle Dietrich to Jerry and/or Ed Anderson on April 10, 1998, or any other property transferred to them since April 10, 1998.
