#### MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATIVE OPERATIONS AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Cooperative Operations Agreement (this "Memorandum"), is made as of May 3, 1999, between Newmont Gold Company, a Delaware corporation ("Newmont"), whose address is 1700 Lincoln Street, Suite 2800, Denver, Colorado 80203, and Barrick Goldstrike Mines Inc., a Colorado corporation ("Barrick"), whose address is P. O. Box 29, Elko, Nevada 89803.

Newmont and Barrick are parties to a Cooperative Operations Agreement (the "Agreement") dated as of May 3, 1999. This Memorandum summarizes certain principal terms of the Agreement.

- 1. <u>Description of Affected Real Property</u>. The Agreement affects all or portions of property located in Eureka County, Nevada more particularly identified on <u>Exhibit A</u> hereto (the "Property"), portions of which, or certain interests in which, are owned by Barrick and portions of which, or certain interests in which, are owned by Newmont.
- 2. <u>Term of Agreement</u>. The Agreement will continue to be effective for so long as either Newmont or Barrick continues to conduct Operations as described in the Agreement, including related reclamation and environmental compliance activities, in or with respect to portions of the Property.
- 3. <u>Description of Agreement</u>. The Agreement sets forth the agreement between Newmont and Barrick with respect to the coordination of their respective Operations on or under the Property.
- 4. <u>Character of Covenants and Easements in Agreement</u>. The covenants and easements set forth in the Agreement affecting the Property, including those described in this Memorandum, shall inure to the benefit of, or bind, as applicable, Newmont and Barrick and their respective successors and assigns, and shall run with and burden the Property.
- 5. <u>Easements Granted in Agreement</u>. Pursuant to the Agreement, Barrick granted and conveyed to Newmont, for the term of the Agreement, the following easements, exercisable in accordance with the terms and limitations of the Agreement:

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(a) an exclusive (subject to the rights of Barrick under the Agreement) easement to use and occupy the 4900 Site, the 4350 Yard, the 4480 Five Acre Yard, the 4480 Seven Acre Yard, the 4480 Intended Final Yard or the 4480 Alternate Final Yard, the 4480 Bench, the 4480 Backup Sites (as may be relocated from time to time pursuant to the Agreement), the 4480 Panhandle, and the 5560 Site, and to install, construct, maintain and use thereon the 4350 Portal, the 4480 Initial and Extended Portals and any and all other facilities (including but not limited to a backfill plant, vent raises and utility boreholes) useful or necessary to Newmont in the conduct of its Operations and consistent with the Agreement, and each as more fully described on the Exhibits hereto as follows:

Exhibit B-1: the 4350 Yard, the 4480 Five Acre Yard, the 4480 Bench, the 4350 Portal and the 4480 Initial Portal;

Exhibit B-2: the 4900 Site, the 4480 Seven Acre Yard and the 4480 Extended Portal;

Exhibit B-3: the 4480 Intended Final Yard;

Exhibit B-4: the 4480 Alternate Final Yard and 4480 Panhandle;

Exhibits B-6 and B-7: the 4480 Backup Sites; and

Exhibit B-8: the 5560 Site;

- (b) an exclusive (except with respect to Barrick) easement to utilize that portion of the subsurface of the Property owned by Barrick for construction, maintenance, occupancy, working and use of underground mine drifts and workings of the Deep Post Underground Mine in accordance with the Underground Mine Plan, generally as depicted on Exhibit B-5 hereto;
- (c) a nonexclusive easement of vehicular and pedestrian ingress and egress to and from the Betze-Post Mine for purposes of Newmont's Operations, exercisable in the manner and subject to the limitations stated in the Agreement, including but not limited to use of the Backfill Ramp, the South Ramp, the Initial Primary Access Route, the Secondary Access Route, and ramps to the 4900 Site and the 5560 Site; and
- (d) a nonexclusive easement to install, construct, maintain, operate and use facilities for the provision of utilities and other services useful or necessary to the Deep Post Underground Mine and Newmont's Operations, including but not limited to electrical lines, water lines, pumps, tanks, drains, vents, dewatering equipment, communications facilities and utility boreholes, some uses being more fully described on Exhibits H, N-1, N-2, and N-3, located and exercisable in the manner and subject to the limitations in the Agreement.
- (e) a non-exclusive easement to install, construct, maintain, operate and use a communications repeater facility with a direct line-of-sight to the Chevas Peak communications site, exercisable in the manner and subject to the limitations stated in the Agreement.

- 6. Covenants Related to Operations. The Agreement sets out certain terms and conditions under which each Party covenants to conduct its respective Operations. In particular, the Agreement sets out certain terms and conditions under which Barrick may construct and operate the Betze-Post Mine according to the Open Pit Mine Plan and may backfill portions of the Betze-Post Mine with waste rock according to the Backfill Plan. Likewise, the Agreement sets out certain terms and conditions under which Newmont may construct and operate the Deep Post Underground Mine according to the Underground Mine Plan. The terms and conditions of the Agreement also contain covenants with respect to the design and operation of facilities constructed on the Property, blasting and underground support, and related matters.
- 7. <u>Definitions</u>. All capitalized terms used herein and not otherwise defined shall have the meanings ascribed to such terms in the Agreement.

This Memorandum has been executed and recorded as notice of the Agreement in lieu of recording the Agreement itself. This Memorandum is not intended to and shall not modify, limit or otherwise alter the terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement. If an inconsistency exists between the Agreement and this Memorandum, the Agreement shall control.

Barrick and Newmont have executed this Memorandum on the day and year first above written.





# Exhibit B-3 4480 Intended Final Yard









4480 Backup Site A






5560 Site







Pipeline Corridor




Exhibit N1. Pipeline Corridors April 1999 to December 2000

## Pipeline Corridor 2




Exhibit N2. Pipeline Corridors December 2000 to December 2002





Exhibit N-3
