GEOLOGICAL & ROCK GEOCHEMICAL SURVEY REPORT

September 10, 1999

This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Federal Mining Law "30 USC 28-1, 28-2; 43 CFR 3851.2" for the following claims:

Valid No. 11 thru Valid No. 20

These form a contiguous group of 10 lode mining claims situated in the unnamed Mining District of Eureka County, State of Nevada.

The work consisted of reconnaisance geological mapping of entire claim block and random rock sampling of all available outcrops. This work was done to evaluate the discovery of valuable mineral deposits located thereon and to assist in planning further exploration and development work. The work was performed intermittently between the dates of May 1st and August 31st, 1999 by Bob Goodson of P.O.Box 578, Elko, Nevada, 89803, a geologist of 20 years experience in exploration with a degree from Colorado State University(B.Sc. in Geology, 1979). The cost of the geological and rock sampling surveys exceeded \$1,000.00.

The rock outcrop samples were crushed and ground, panned and stained to detect the presence of heavy metals and minerals. The results from these samples were very encouraging. Gold, barite and several lead and zinc minerals were detected in many of the samples.

The geological mapping survey is very encouraging. The rocks of the property consists of Pennsylvanian to Ordovician sedimentary rocks(limestones, dolomites, sandstones, siltstones, shales, cherts and argillites) that have been intruded by Tertiary rhyolite domes, sills and dikes. Numerous high-angle faults are present throughout the property with associated zones of breccias, silicification "jasperoids" and impressive widespread hydrothermal barite veining. The geological mapping indicates that geologic factors similar to other known mineralized properties and ore deposits in the region occur within the boundaries of the subject mining claims. Many strong structures and several favorable host rock types for controlling mineralization were identified within the claim boundary.

An exploration-development program consisting of further geological, geochemical and geophysical surveys is being considered for this property. These surveys would be followed by detailed trenching, drilling and sampling. All technical work and results are in the possession of Bob Goodson, geologist.
