Thissurvey was made with a Hewlett-Packard Electronic Total Statn, Model No. 3820A, Serial No. 1650A00201, which utilizes eleconic horizontal and vertical circles that display measured horintal and zenith angles directly in degrees, minutes, and seccs. All lines of this survey were measured with this instment which uses a laser beam to measure the slope dist. from the strument toward a reflector located at the point to be meased. The slope dist. is reduced to hor. dist. within the instment by an electronic computing device and displays the hor. distdirectly to the nearest thousandth of a ft. The instrument was sted and calibrated on a base line of known length before and ter this survey was completed and found to be in good adjument during the time that this survey was executed.

Bearys referred to in this record were determined by the average of t hor. angle measurements, one with the telescope in the dir. posion, and one with the telescope in the rev. position. These angl were referred to the meridian by the following obsertions:




