FEET

This survey was made with a Hewlett-Packard Electronic Total Station, Model No. 3820A, Serial No. 1650A00201, which utilizes electronic horizontal and vertical circles that display measured horizontal and zenith angles directly in degrees, minutes, and seconds. All lines of this survey were measured with this instrument which uses a laser beam to measure the slope distance from the instrument toward a reflector located at the point to be measured. The slope distance is reduced to horizontal distance within the instrument by an electronic computing device and displays the horizontal distance directly to the nearest thousandth of a foot. The instrument was tested and calibrated on a base line of known length before and after this survey was completed and found to be in good adjustment during the time that this survey was executed.

Bearings referred to in this record were determined by the average of the horizontal angle measurements, one with the telescope in the direct position, and one with the telescope in the reverse position. These angles were referred to the meridian by the following observations:

May 1, 1993, at Cor. No. 3 of the TARA 47 lode, at latitude $41^{\circ}03.3''$ N., and longitude $116^{\circ}25'06.3''$ W., NAD 27, elevation approximately 5520 ft. above sea level, and temperature 65° F., make series of eight observations on the sun for azimuth at approximately equal time intervals, four each with the telescope in the direct position and reverse position, observing the horizontal angle right from Cor. No. 2 of the TARA 47 lode and the zenith angle to the center of the sun, using a Roelofs Solar Prism.

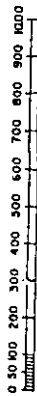

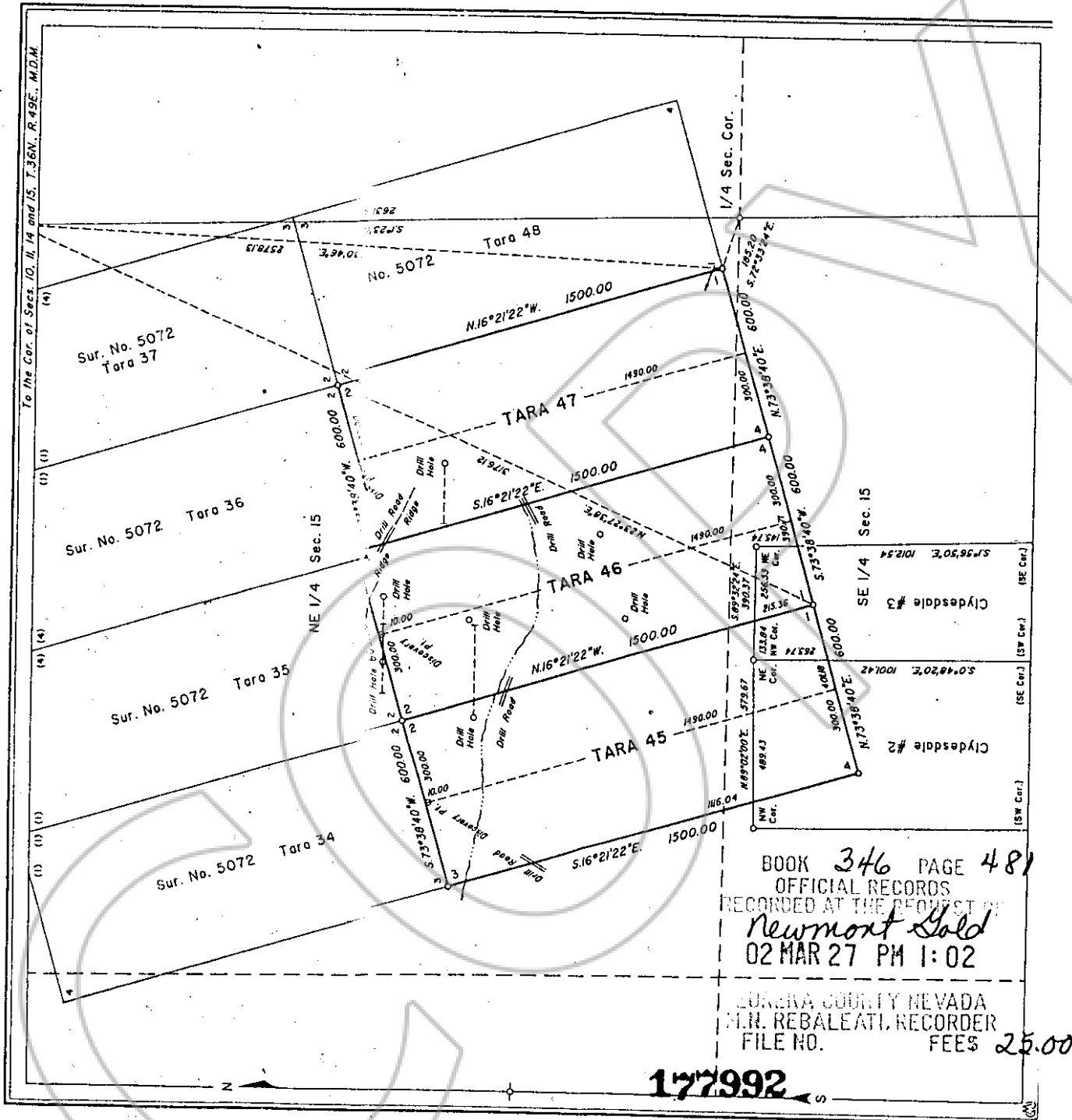
