BORROWER for Borrower's self, lower's heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRANTS the property unto Trustee for the benefit of the Governat against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever except any liens, encumbrances, easements, reservations, or conveyance speed hereinabove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES as follows:

(1) To pay promptly when due any inordness to the Government hereby secured.

(2) To pay to the Government such feeld other charges as may now or hereafter be required by Government regulations.

(3) If required by the Government, take additional monthly payments of 1/12 of the estimated annual taxes, assessments,

insurance premiums and other charges upon mortgaged premises.

- (4) The Government may at any time puny other amounts including advances for payment of prior or junior liens, required herein to be paid by Borrower and not paid by Bower when due, as well as any costs and expenses for the preservation, protection, or enforcement of this lien, as advances for Boyer's account. All such advances shall bear interest at the rate borne by the note which has the highest interest rate.
- (5) All advances by the Government, isding advances for payment of prior or junior liens, in addition to any advances required by the terms of the note, as described by this rument, with interest shall be immediately due and payable by Borrower to the Government without demand at the price designated in thtest note and shall be secured hereby. No such advance by the Government shall relieve Borrower from breach of Borrower's coven to pay. - (7) To pay when due all taxes, liens, gments, encumbrances, and assessments lawfully attaching to or assessed against the property, including all charges and assessn's in connection with water, water rights, and water stock pertaining to or reasonably necessary to the use of the real property detied above, and promptly deliver to the Government without demand receipt evidencing such payments.
- (8) To keep the property insured as rered by and under insurance policies approved by the Government and, at its requests to deliver such policies to the Government. Thount collected under any fire or other insurance policy may be applied by the Government upon the loan or any other indebtedness securely this instrument in such order as the Government may determine, or at the Government's option may be released to Borrower.
- (9) To maintain improvement in goodpair and make repairs required by the Government; operate the property in a good and husbandmanlike manner; comply with such in conservation practices and farm and home management plans as the Government from time to time may prescribe; and not to abara the property, or cause or permit waste, lessening or impairment of the security covered hereby, or, without the written consent of thovernment, cut, remove, or lease any timber, gravel, oil, gas, coal, or other minerals except as may be necessary for ordinary domestic poses.

(10) To comply with all laws, ordinan and regulations affecting the property.
