## **LEASE AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, on the ? day of September, 1975, the Board of County Commissioners of Eureka County (County) of the Diamond Valley Baptist Church (Church) entered into a written lease agreement fc term of ninety-nine (99) years, permitting the County to lease from the Church a 83' x 10 ot to be used as a fire station in Diamond Valley; and

WHEREAS, on the h day of September, 1988, the County, acting on behalf of the Diamond Valley Volunteer e Department, entered into a written agreement with Clay and Ermyle Cooper (Cooper), bling upon their heirs, assigns, and successors, to secure water for the fire station; and

WHEREAS, the Cety learned the fire station improvements extend beyond the perimeter of the 83' x 100' leased to the County by the Church; and

WHEREAS, the Coty permitted the Diamond Valley Weed District to maintain a building upon the leased land

WHEREAS, the Coty acknowledges the agreement with Cooper is revocable upon six (6) months notice; and

WHEREAS, the Coty and Church wish to clarify the 1975 lease agreement by replacing it with this new atement to better define the perimeter of the leased premises and the permissible uses of thend leased.

NOW THEREFORTHIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on the date and year written above, and regres in all respects the 1975 lease agreement between the Church and County.

IT IS AGREED AN UNDERSTOOD the Church, its heirs, assigns, and successors, hereby lease the followind property to the County for a term of nincty-nine (99) years, beginning September 22.75: all of the real property within Diamond Valley, Eureka County, Nevada, describen attachment A to this Agreement (legal description and map),

now owned by the Church.

IT IS AGREED ANUNDERSTOOD the leased lot shall be used for the purpose of a fire station for fire protects of Diamond Valley, Eureka, Nevada, and may include such fixtures as are necessary to ry out that purpose, including but not limited to building(s), gravel, and a well. In addit, the County may permit the Diamond Valley Weed District to maintain a storage facilion the leased lot.

IT IS AGREED AN UNDERSTOOD that no fire drills, practices, or other nonemergency activities will beheduled at the fire house to be held on Sunday mornings so as to interfere with Churciervices, and the fire station will not be used for religious purposes.

IT IS AGREED ANUNDERSTOOD the Church warrants it owns the leased land but the County assumes all ponsibility for the leased land during the lease and shall hold the Church harmless againsny liability or lawsuits.

IT IS AGREED AN UNDERSTOOD that only in the event the leased property ceases to be used for the puse stated in this Agreement shall it revert back to the Church, the Church's successors, its or assigns, and this Agreement terminate prior to the expiration of the lease term

IT IS FURTHER ACEED AND UNDERSTOOD the consideration to be paid by the County to the Church this lease shall be 12,000 (Twelve Thousand) square feet in paving to benefit the Chur at such time the Gold Street paving project is accomplished. At the time this lease expit the County may remove any and all fixtures placed upon the land, but may also (with the nurch's permission) leave certain fixtures upon the land for the benefit of the Church.


