OFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE EUIKA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ND JONATHON J. HUTCHINGS, Ph.D.

THIS AGREEENT for professional services is made and entered into this 5th day of January, 2001, by a between JONATHON J. HUTCHINGS, Ph.D. (hereinafter NATURAL RESOUIES MANAGER OR "NRM"), and EUREKA COUNTY, a political subdivision one State of Nevada, acting by its Board of Commissioners (hereinafter "COUNT") with reference to the following facts:

- A. The COUN' is continually confronted by public lands and related issues that require the COUNTY in mediate and informed response.
- B. The NATULL RESOURCE MANAGER is an independent contractor who serves as the head of ticounty's Department of Natural Resources, and coordinates the COUNTY's prompessonse to public lands and related issues.
- C. JONATHO!. HUTCHINGS, Ph.D., has offered to serve as the NRM and work with both the CONTY's Public Lands Advisory Commission and Board of Commissioners to ensi the COUNTY's informed involvement and prompt response to public lands and relatersues that impact the COUNTY.
- D. In order to sure his availability, the County offers this agreement for professional services.

NOW THEREIRE, on the basis of the foregoing facts and in consideration of the mutual covenants and reements contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. RELATIONIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

During the term this agreement, the NRM shall receive no benefits other than those specifically stategere, and understands and agrees he shall be an independent contractor to the COUTY. The NRM also understands and agrees he shall not be eligible for medical insunce, pension payments, or any other benefit normally available to a full time employee of COUNTY. The NRM further agrees he is responsible for all appropriate tax withhoug and compliance with all state and federal laws.

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2. REPORTIN REQUIREMENT

The NRM shalttend and report to all meetings of the COUNTY's Public Lands Advisory Commission d Board of Commissioners, unless excused by illness, or other duties to be performed the COUNTY, or other planned absence. The NRM shall receive input and direon from both Boards, but in the event of conflict the decision of the Board of Commission supercedes all other direction and input.

3. OFFICE SECE

As a benefit of s agreement, the NRM shall have the use of office space and office equipment located in: COUNTY's Natural Resource Office, and be provided keys to that Office. Any requ for office supplies must follow County policy.

4. STAFF SUDRT

As a benefit of s agreement, the NRM shall have staff support available from the secretary of the Publicands Advisory Commission, limited to no more than twenty (20) hours per week. Addinal support, if required, must be approved by the Board of Commissioners.

5. PLACE OF RFORMANCE

The NRM, at aimes this agreement is in effect, shall reside in Eureka County and perform the bulk of hiuties in the COUNTY's Natural Resource Office.

6. <u>COMPENS, ION</u>

As a benefit of s agreement, the NRM shall be paid Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00) per calent year for his full time professional services to the COUNTY, payable in installments one time per calendar month.

7. TRAVEL

As a benefit of s agreement, the NRM shall be reimbursed at the rate of \$.325 per mile for each mile travel on business in his own vehicle to perform his duties under this agreement, excluding trel incidental to and from the place of performance. Out of state travel must be pre-appred by the Board of Commissioners. On business travel trips the NRM shall also receive meal stipend at a rate consistent with current County policy in addition to a reasonablodging cost reimbursement. These will be pre-approved.

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8. TERM OF IIS AGREEMENT

The NRM agra to provide his services to the COUNTY for calendar years 2001 and 2002. During thisme, the NRM further agrees to devote his time entirely to the NRM's advocacy role: the COUNTY, and do no other compensated work.

9. TERMINAON OF THIS AGREEMENT

This agreementary be terminated for any reason or no reason at all by either party in sixty(60) calendar dr by providing written notice of the termination at the COUNTY's Natural Resource Off.

10. WORK PHOUCT

The NRM und tands and agrees his reports, compilations, and all other work prepared for the COUTY shall be and remain the COUNTY's property, to be kept in an orderly fashion at the tural Resource Office. Any civil litigation or other liability arising out of this work that is mmenced by a third party shall be defended by the County.

11. HOLD HAMLESS

If a dispute arisover the interpretation or application of this agreement, both parties agree to bear the own costs and attorney fees and not seek reimbursement from the other party. In adon, both parties agree to hold each other harmless from and against all claims other an those based upon the failure to provide benefits as described in this agreement.

12. MISCELL/EOUS

The obligations d duties of the NRM are personal and not assignable. This agreement shall be govied by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Nevada. The parties fn time to time may waive any or all rights herein without effecting a waiver with respect trny subsequent occurrences or transactions hereunder. This written agreement condutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties and there are no other agreements or understandings, written or oral, in effect between the parties.
