THIRT:NTH AMENDMENT TO TONKIN MINING LEASE

Amendment Numr Thirteen dated February 1, 2003 ("Effective Date"), between Lyle F. Impbell Trust and Julian E. and Jean C. Simpson, husband and wife, (collectivy "Lessors") and Tonkin Springs Venture LP ("TSVLP" or "Lessee").

RECITALS

- A. Lessors id Lessee are parties to a certain Mining Lease ("Mining Lease") ated effective January 1, 1986, a Memorandum (the "Memordum" of which was recorded in Book 148, at Page 110, as Recepti No. 104566, and amended on January 10, 1986, September 29, 198June 10, 1987, August 29, 1988, January 11, 1989, June 29, 1989, At 18, 1990, April 20, 1992, January 22, 1993, April 30, 1993, June 28993 and November 27, 1995 of the real property records of Eureka aunty, Nevada.
- B. Section: Term; Rule Against Perpetuities and Severability of Paragras in part states that "... this Lease shall remain in force for a term twenty (20) years from the date hereof and for so long thereaf as there is production of one or more Leased Substances from the ineral Prospect, ..."
- C. Lesseend Lessors desire to amend the first paragraph only of Section to the Tonkin Mining Lease and to the Memorandum to change primary term of the Lease from twenty (20) years to twenty-three (2 years.

NOW THERE)RE, in consideration of the foregoing and of the mutual benefits to be rived, Lessee and Lessors agree as follows:

1. The first ragraph of Section 2. <u>Term; Rule Against Perpetuities and Severability Paragraphs</u> shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the fowing:

Subject to 3 other provisions herein contained, this Lease shall remain in force for arm of twenty-three (23) years from the date hereof and for so long thereer as there is production of one or more Leased Substances from the heral Prospect, or any operations permitted hereunder are being concted on the Mineral Prospect or this Lease is continued in force by rson of any of the provisions hereof; provided, however, the term of the Lease shall not exceed 99 years. During any period of

extension bond the primary term hereof, all of the terms and conditions of this Leashall remain in full force and effect.

2. Except as rended by this Thirteenth Amendment and the prior twelve amendmen all of the terms and conditions of the Mining Lease shall remain in fuorce and effect.
