ORDER TMINATING TRUST AND APPROVING FINAL DISTRIBUTION OF TRUST ASSETS

19, 1990. Sin that time, they have been and continue to act as Co-Trustees of the W. G. Austin Trus

- 3. Eanne T. Welts, the widow of W. G. Austin and the mother of Gregory G. Austin and Sun Genevish was the sole income beneficiary of the W. G. Austin Trust. Suzanne T. Ws died on February 2, 2002. Upon her death, under the terms of the trust created under 3 Will of W. G. Austin, the trust is to terminate and all assets of the trust are to be distrited equally between Gregory G. Austin and Susan Genevish.
- 4. Ggory G. Austin and Susan Genevish, as the sole beneficiaries of the trust, have waived the quirement of any accounting that may be due from them as Co-Trustees of the trust.

All otherlegations of the Petition having been found to be true and correct, the Court now entrithe following Orders:

- A. Geory G. Austin and Susan Genevish are not required to file any accounting of a trust.
- B. W. G. Austin Trust is terminated and Gregory G. Austin and Susan Genevish are thorized, directed, and empowered to distribute to themselves, free of trust, all remang assets of the trust equally or on a nonpro-rata basis, as they shall determine by reement between them.
- C. And the assets to be so distributed pursuant to paragraph B. above are the following ri estate and mining claims, as further described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorated herein by this reference:


