together with all rights (including the rigto mining products, gravel, oil, gas, coal or other minerals), interests, easements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, rents, issues, and profits thereof and revenues and income therefrom (subject to the right of the Government to collect and apply the le as provided in Covenant (31) of this instrument); all improvements, all water, water rights, water stock, and sprinkling and irrigative tem, pertaining thereto, and all payments at any time owing to Borrower by virtue of any sale, lease, transfer, conveyance, or commation of any part thereof or interest therein-all of which are herein called "the property."

IN TRUST, NEVERTHELESS, at all times when the note is held by the Government, or in the event the Government should assign this instrument to secure prompt ment of the note and any renewals and extensions thereof and any agreements contained therein, and (b) to secure the prompt paent of all advances and expenditures made by the Government, with interest, as hereinafter described and the performance of every enant and agreement of Borrower contained herein or in any supplementary agreement.

BORROWER for Borrower's sallorrower's heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRANTS the property unto Trustee for the benefit of the Govment against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever except any liens, encumbrances, easements, reservations, or conveyance cified hereinabove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES as follows:

- (1) To pay promptly when due any ebtedness to the Government hereby secured.
- (2) To pay to the Government suchs and other charges as may now or hereafter be required by Government regulations.
- (3) If required by the Government make additional monthly payments of 1/12 of the estimated annual taxes, assessments, insurance premiums and other charges u the mortgaged premises.
- (4) The Government may at any tinuy any other amounts including advances for payment of prior or junior liens, required herein to be paid by Borrower and not paid borrower when due, as well as any costs and expenses for the preservation, protection, or enforcement of this lien, as advances for rower's account. All such advances shall bear interest at the rate borne by the note which has the highest interest rate.
- (5) All advances by the Governmencluding advances for payment of prior or junior liens, in addition to any advances required by the terms of the note, as described by tinstrument, with interest shall be immediately due and payable by Borrower to the Government without demand at the price designated ne latest note and shall be secured hereby. No such advance by the Government shall relieve Borrower from breach of Borrower's count to pay. Any payment made by Borrower may be applied on the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, in any or the Government determines.
  - (6) To use the loan evidenced by thote solely for purposes authorized by the Government.
- (7) To pay when due all taxes, lie judgments, encumbrances, and assessments lawfully attaching to or assessed against the property, including all charges and assents in connection with water, water rights, and water stock pertaining to or reasonably necessary to the use of the real property cribed above, and promptly deliver to the Government without demand receipt evidencing such payments.
- (8) To keep the property insured acquired by and under insurance policies approved by the Government and, at its requests to deliver such policies to the Government. amount collected under any fire or other insurance policy may be applied by the Government upon the loan or any other indebtedness seed by this instrument in such order as the Government may determine, or at the Government's option may be released to Borrower.
- (9) To maintain improvement in grepair and make repairs required by the Government; operate the property in a good and husbandmanlike manner; comply with strarm conservation practices and farm and home management plans as the Government from time to time may prescribe; and not to adon the property, or cause or permit waste, lessening or impairment of the security covered hereby, or, without the written consent of Government, cut, remove, or lease any timber, gravel, oil, gas, coal, or other minerals except as may be necessary for ordinary domesourposes.
  - (10) To comply with all laws, ordices, and regulations affecting the property.
- (11) To pay or reimburse the Goverent for expenses reasonably necessary or incidental to the protection of the lien and priority hereof and to the enforcement of or the conance with the provisions hereof and of the note and any supplementary agreement (whether before or after default) including but not ited to costs of evidence of title to and survey of the property, costs of recording this and other instruments, attorney's fees, trustees' fecourt costs, and expenses of advertising, selling, and conveying the property.
- (12) Except as otherwise provided Sovernment regulations, neither the property nor any portion thereof or interest therein shall be leased, assigned, sold, transferred or umbered, voluntarily or otherwise, without the written consent of the Government. The Government shall have the sole and exceve rights as beneficiary hereunder including but not limited to the power to grant consents, partial releases, subordinations, and satistion.
- (13) At all reasonable times the Govment and its agents may inspect the property to ascertain whether the covenants and agreements contained herein or in any supplementary reement are being performed.
- (14) The Government may (a) adjune interest rate, payment, terms or balance due on the loan, (b) increase the mortgage by an amount equal to deferred interest on the standing principal balance, (c) extend or defer the maturity of and renew and reschedule the payments on, the debt evidenced by the nor any indebtedness to the Government secured by this instrument, (d) release any party who is liable under the note or for the debt frenability to the Government, (e) release portions of the property and subordinate its lien, and (f) waive any other of its rights under this rument. Any and all this can and will be done without affecting the lien or the priority of this instrument or Borrower's or any other py's liability to the Government for payment of the note or debt secured by this instrument unless the Government says otherwise in ting. HOWEVER, any forbearance by the Government-whether once or often-in exercising any right or remedy under this instrument otherwise afforded by applicable law shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any such right or remedy.

- (15) If at any time it shall appear be Government that Borrower may be able to obtain a loan from a production credit association, a Federal land bank, or other response cooperative or private credit source, at reasonable rates and terms for loans for similar purposes and periods of time, Borrower will, to the Government's request, apply for and accept such loan in sufficient amount to pay the note and any indebtedness secured herebyl to pay for any stock necessary to be purchased in a cooperative lending agency in connection with such loan.
- (16) Default hereunder shall conute default under any other real estate, or personal property or other security instrument held by the Government and executed or assed by Borrower, and default under any such other security instrument shall constitute default hereunder.
- (17) SHOULD DEFAULT occu the performance or discharge of any obligation in this instrument or secured by this instrument, or should the parties named as Borroweie or be declared incompetent, or should any one of the parties named as Borrower be discharged in bankruptcy or declared an insolver make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, the Government, at its option with or without notice, may: (a) declare the entire annt unpaid under the note and any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured immediately due and payable, (b) for the account fortower incur and pay reasonable expenses for repair or maintenance of and take possession of, operate or rent the property, (c) uporplication by it and production of this instrument, without other evidence and without notice of hearing of said application, have a rever appointed for the property, with the usual powers of receivers in like cases, and (d) authorize and request Trustee to foreclose this rument and sell the property as provided by law, (e) bring an action to foreclose this instrument, obtain a deficiency judgment, or enfe any other remedy provided by law.
- (18) At the request of the Governnt, Trustee may foreclose this instrument by advertising and sale of the property as provided by law, for cash or secured credit at the con of the Government, personal notice of which sale need not be served on Borrower; and at such sale the Government and its agents noid and purchase as a stranger; Trustee at Trustee's option may conduct such sale without being personally present, through Trustee's egate authorized by Trustee for such purpose orally or in writing; and Trustee's execution of a conveyance of the property or any parereof to any purchaser at foreclosure sale shall be conclusive evidence that the sale was conducted by Trustee personally or through Trus's delegate duly authorized in accordance herewith.
- (19) The proceeds of foreclosurde shall be applied in the following order to the payment of: (a) costs and expenses incident to enforcing or complying with the proons hereof, (b) any prior liens required by law or a competent court to be so paid, (c) the debt evidenced by the note and all indebtess to the Government secured hereby, (d) inferior liens of record required by law or a competent court to be so paid, (e) at the Government's option, any other indebtedness of Borrower owing to the Government, and (f) any balance to Borrower. In case the Government is successful bidder at foreclosure or other sale of all or any part of the property, the Government may pay its share of the purchase post or defining such amount on any debts of Borrower owing to the Government, in the order prescribed above.
- (20) All powers and agencies gied in this instrument are coupled with an interest and are irrevocable by death or otherwise; and the rights and remedies provided in instrument are cumulative to remedies provided by law.
- (21) Borrower agrees that the cernment will not be bound by any present or future State laws, (a) providing for homestead or exemption of the property, (b) prohibg maintenance of an action for a deficiency judgment or limiting the amount thereof or the time within which such action must be bight, (c) prescribing any other statute of limitations, or (d) limiting the conditions which the Government may by regulation impunctuding the interest rate it may charge, as a condition of approving a transfer of the property to a new Borrower, Borrower expressly was the benefit of any such State laws.
- (22) If any part of the loan for wh this instrument is given shall be used to finance the purchase, construction or repair of property to be used as an owner-occupied dwing (herein called "the dwelling") and if Borrower intends to sell or rent the dwelling and has obtained the Government's consent to so (a) neither Borrower nor anyone authorized to act for Borrower will, after receipt of a bona fide offer, refuse to negotiate for thue or rental of the dwelling or will otherwise make unavailable or deny the dwelling to anyone because of race, color, religion, sex, tonal origin, handicap, familial status, or age, and (b) Borrower recognizes as illegal and hereby disclaims, and will not comply with attempt to enforce restrictive covenants on the dwelling relating to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, handicap, familial sta, or age.
- (23) If Borrower has a permit opproved application for the appropriation of water for use on or for the benefit of the property, hereinabove described, Borrower werform and complete all the action and fulfill all the conditions necessary to perfect such water right; and in the event of Borrower's lure to do so, the Government shall have the right to complete such action and to advance such sums as may be necessary for such pose, such advances to be secured by this instrument.
- (24) If the property, or any partreof, is a lease or a purchaser's interest in a contract of sale, Borrower will pay when due all rents, contract payments and any and all or charges required by said lease or contract, will comply with all other requirements of said lease or contract, and will not surrender or nquish, without the Government's written consent, any of Borrower's right, title and interest in or to the property or the lease or court while this instrument remains in effect.
- (25) Borrower has assigned or ved or will immediately, on request of the Government, assign or waive in favor of the Government all grazing privileges, permits, licen or leases appurtenant to or used in connection with said land, and Borrower further covenants and agrees to produce renewals thereofor to their expiration, to pay all fees and charges and to perform all acts and to do all things necessary to keep and preserve all sarazing rights and renewals thereof, and in the event of the failure of Borrower to do any of these things the Government may do so orbalf of Borrower, including advancing such sums as may be necessary for this purpose and such funds advanced shall be secured by instrument.

- (26) Borrower further agrees: the loans secured by this instrument will be in default should any loan proceeds be used for a purpose that will contribute to exsive erosion of highly erodible land, or the conversion of wetlands to produce an agricultural commodity as prohibited by 7 C.F. art 1940, subpart G.
- (27) This instrument shall be ject to the present Government regulations, and to its future regulations not inconsistent with the express provisions hereof.
- (28) Notices, including any Ne of Default and Notice of Sale, shall be sent by certified mail, unless otherwise required by law, and addressed, unless and until somher address is designated in a notice so given, in the case of both Trustee and the Government to the address stated above and in the e of Borrower at the post office address shown above.
- (29) Upon full and final paymof all indebtedness hereby secured and the performance and discharge of each and every condition, agreement and obligation, continger otherwise, contained herein or secured hereby, the Government shall request Trustee to execute and deliver to Borrower at Borrowe address a full reconveyance of the property within 60 days after written demand by Borrower, and Borrower hereby waives the benefit all laws requiring earlier execution or delivery of such reconveyance.
- (30) This instrument also sect future advances to Borrower when evidenced by notes for any loans made by the Government, subject to the same terms and conons regarding assignment of said notes as provided in this instrument and all references in this instrument shall be deemed to inclusich future notes. The future advances are at the option of the Government. The maximum amount to be secured as future advances wit evidenced by, and stated in, a promissory note or notes reciting that they are secured by this deed of trust.
- (31) As additional security, Bewer assigns to and confers upon the Government the power to collect the rents, issues, profits and income of the property, reserving to rower the right to collect and retain same prior to any default under this instrument. The Government may apply said rents and other ince on the loan or any indebtedness secured by this instrument in any order it may determine and without regard to the adequacy of srity for same.
- (32) Any aware for damages ojury to the property, including any award for its condemnation for public use, is assigned to the Government which may apply or rese the money in the same manner and with the same effect as provided in Covenant (8).
- (33) The Government may, fi time to time, as provided by statute, or by a writing, signed, acknowledged and recorded in the offices of the county recorders of thoresaid counties appoint another Trustee in place and stead of Trustee named in this instrument and thereupon, the Trustee named his instrument shall be discharged and Trustee so appointed shall be substituted as Trustee under this instrument with the same effec of originally named Trustee in this instrument.
- (34) If any provision of this imment or application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity will not

affect other provisions or application the instrument when the provisions hereof are declaro be severable.	nich can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to that
