MEMORANDUM OF MINING LEASE

THIS MEMORANDUM OF MINING LEASE (the "Agreement"), dated effective as of Locil 22, 2005 (the "Effective Date") is between HOMESTAKE MINING COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, a California corporation, with offices at the Ruby Hill Mine located at the Intersection of US Highway 50 and State Route 278 near Eureka, Nevada 89316 ("Homestake"), and CENTURY GOLD LLC, a Nevada limited liability company, with offices at 285 Spring Creek Parkway, #1, Spring Creek, Nevada 89815 ("Century") shall provide notice that the parties shown above have entered into a Mining Lease as of the Effective Date. The pertinent terms of the Mining Lease are:

- 1. <u>Lease and Term.</u> (a) Homestake owns certain lands situated in Eureka County, Nevada, which lands are more particularly described as the Hoosac Patented Lode Claim, M.S. 60, as generally located in Sections 13 and 14, Township 18 North, Range 53 East, with the Homestake's entire interest in said lands referred to herein as the "Mining Property".
