ORDER APPROVING SECOND AND FINAL ACCOUNTING, PETITION FOR FINAL DISTRIBUTION AND FOR APPROVAL OF ATTORNEY'S COSTS AND FEES

PAULA J. - 2. That the Executor is authorized and directed to pay the sum of \$326.00 to David E. Adkins, Esq., for reimbursement of costs advanced on behalf of the Estate, and any further closing costs and fees that may accrue.

3. That after payment of the foregoing fees, costs and closing costs, the Petitioner is authorized and directed to distribute all assets of the Estate, now known or hereafter discovered, pursuant to the Last Will and Testament of Decedent.
