**MEMORANDUM OF OIL AND GAS LEASE**

WITNESSETH: That Lessor, for a valuable consideration and in consideration of the covenants of the Lessee set forth in that certain Oil and Gas Lease made and entered into the 12th day of March, 2008, by and between the parties hereto, has granted, demised, leased and let and by these presents does grant, demise, lease and let unto the said Lessee, exclusively for the sole and only purpose of investigating, exploring by geophysical or other means, prospecting, drilling, mining and operating for oil and gas, and laying pipelines, and building tanks, power stations and structures thereon to produce, save and take care of said products, all of the lands situated in **Counties of Elko and Eureka, State of Nevada** described as follows, to wit:

Township 29 North, Range 52 East
Section 11: All

containing **640.00 acres**, more or less, which lands are sometimes referred to as the "Lease Premises."

The term of said Oil and Gas Lease shall be for a term of **Five (5) Years** from the date set forth above, and so long thereafter as oil and gas, or any of them, is produced in paying quantities from said Lease Premises, or from lands with which the Lease Premises may be pooled, or drilling or re-working operations are conducted thereon as provided therein.





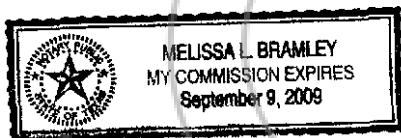
