The Claim is approximately 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide, such that 10 feet are claimed in a West direction and 1490 feet in an East direction from the point of discovery (monument of location), at which the Notice of Location was posted, together with 300 feet on each side of the monument of location and center line of the Claim. The general course of the lode or vein is from the east to the west direction.
