**CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION**

**LODE MINING CLAIM**

Of the COR # 36 lode mining claim.

I, Peter W. Laczay, of lawful age, do hereby certify and declare as follows:

That I maintain a business office at 1228 E. McFarland Ave. Coeur d'Alene, Idaho 83814 and that I am the duly authorized Special Agent of Aaron Groven

That on the 30th October, 2014, the above lode mining claim was duly located in the Unorganized Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada and was recorded under Doc # 0229069 on January 27, 2015

The locator hereby claims 125 feet in a Westerly direction and 1375 feet in Easterly direction from the location monument and 300 feet on each side of said lode or vein. The general course of this claim is East - West.

That the claim is situated all or in part in the following quarter section (s): NE1/4 NE1/4 Section 1, Township 23 North, Range 50 East Mt. Diablo Meridian, and NW1/4 Section 6; Township 23 North; Range 51 East Mt. Diablo Merid.

This claims is described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at the Discovery:

Thence due East 1375 feet to the East end center;  
Thence due South 300 feet to the Southeast corner;  
Thence due West 1500 feet to the Southwest corner;  
Thence due North 600 feet to the Northwest corner;  
Thence due East 1500 feet to the Northeast corner;  
Thence due South 300 feet to the East end center.

That the following reference is hereby made to natural objects and permanent Monuments so as to identify said claim, to wit;

The monument of location is 750 feet southerly and 880 feet westerly from the NE corner of Section 1; T 23 N; Range 50 East. Adjoining claims: Joy 11,13 on north; COR 39 on south; COR 28 on west..

Within 60 days after posting said notice on the ground, the locator defined the boundaries of the claim as required by law and established monuments consisting of 4x4" or 2x2" wooden posts or native timber.

On each monument is a metal tag marked with the name of the claim and a diagram or statement indicating it's location. Location work consisted of making the map in accordance with NRS 517.040, as recorded is accurate.
