## AMENDED ORDER REOPENING THE ESTATE OF ROBERT P. DOUGLASS FOR DISTRIBUTION OF AFTER-DISCOVERED ASSET

This Amended Order supersedes the ORDER TO REOPEN THE ESTATE OF ROBERT P. DOUGLASS AND DISTRIBUTION OF ASSET, filed on January 6, 2015:

The verified Ex Parte Petition of PATRICK E. DOUGLASS,
THOMAS J. FLAHERTY, MICHAEL D. FLAHERTY and TIMOTHY B. DOUGLASS
having been duly submitted to this Court;

The Court now finds that:

1. The heirs, devisees and legatees of Robert P. Douglass are Maxine M. Douglass, individually, Maxine M. Douglass,

Trustee of The Douglass Family Trust, Patrick E. Douglass,
Timothy B. Douglass, Thomas Flaherty and Michael D. Flaherty.

- 2. Maxine M. Douglass died on February 9, 2012.
- 3. The remaining four (4) heirs are the Petitioners herein and Successor Co-Trustees of The Douglass Family Trust.
- 4. Decedent's estate was previously distributed under an Order Setting Aside Estate filed on or about May 26, 1998.
- 5. There exists a mining claim in Eureka County,
  Nevada, held in the name of Decedent and which has only been
  recently discovered by the Petitioners, and which has an
  estimated value of \$5,000.00 and has no known encumbrances.
- 6. The value of the Decedent's probate estate, which consisted of stock worth \$20,000.00 having already been distributed to the Decedent's then living spouse in 1998, and the subject mining claim having been discovered in 2014 worth approximately \$5,000.00, does not exceed \$50,000.00, the limit in effect in 1998 when the Estate was first set aside.
- 7. Pursuant to NRS 155.010(2), this Court has the power to dispense with the notice required to be given under said statute, since all interested parties have appeared as part of this recent Petition.
- 8. Said mining claim should be distributed to The Douglass Family Trust as provided in Article V of Decedent's

 Will referencing real property, and there is good and reasonable cause to reopen the Estate of Robert P. Douglass for that purpose.

Therefore, based on the foregoing and good cause having been previously shown in 1998 for the Estate to be assigned and set apart without administration pursuant to NRS 146.070 and for distribution of the assets of the Decedent's Estate which was made to the Decedent's then surviving spouse, Maxine M.

Douglass; further, good cause having been shown that the newly-discovered mining claim asset of Decedent should be assigned and set apart without administration pursuant to NRS 146.070 and that said mining claim asset be distributed to The Douglass Family Trust,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. That the Petition To Reopen The Estate of Robert P. Douglass and For Distribution of Asset be granted;
- 2. That the newly-discovered Eureka County mining claim be distributed to The Douglass Family Trust, and that this Order constitutes authority for the Petitioners to record this Order with the Eureka County Recorder, and to execute a Deed or other documents conveying title of said mining claim to PATRICK E. DOUGLASS, THOMAS J. FLAHERTY, MICHAEL D. FLAHERTY and TIMOTHY B. DOUGLASS as Co-Trustees of The Douglass Family Trust; and,

3. That notice pursuant to NRS 155.010(1) be dispensed with as the Petitioners are all of the interested persons as defined in the statute.
