If not redeemed, the title to the property shall vest in Eureka County for the benefit of the State and Eureka County. Additionally, a tax lien may be sold against the parcel pursuant to the provisions of NRS 361.731 to 361.733, inclusive.

Until the expiration of the period of redemption, the property held pursuant to this Certificate shall be assessed annually to the Treasurer as Trustee, and before the owner or his successor shall redeem such property he shall also pay the Treasurer holding the Certificate any additional taxes assessed and accrued against the property after the date of this Certificate, together with the interest thereon at the rate of ten (10) percent per annum, assessed monthly, from the date due until paid.
