Interest thereon will be added at the rate of ten (10) percent per annum, assessed monthly, from the date due until paid. The property may be redeemed within two (2) years from the date originally recorded. If not redeemed, the title to the property shall vest in Eureka County for the benefit of the State and Eureka County. Additionally, a tax lien may be sold against the parcel pursuant to the provisions of NRS 361.731 to 361.733, inclusive.

Until the expiration of the period of redemption, the property held pursuant to this Updated Certificate shall be assessed annually to the Treasurer as Trustee, and before the owner or his successor shall redeem such property he shall also pay the Treasurer holding the Updated Certificate any additional taxes assessed and accrued against the property after the date of this Updated Certificate, together with the interest thereon at the rate of ten (10) percent per annum, assessed monthly, from the date due until paid.
