- Petitioner has provided Creditor Notice through publication in the Ely Times commencing on April 16, 2021, for four (4) weeks continuous. Proof of publication was filed with the Court. No creditors came forward. The Creditor's claim period is now closed.


The co-Petitioners have requested the Court ratify, confirm and approve of her payment of accrued attorney's fees in the amount of \$6,177.90 (\$5,871.00 in attorney's fees, \$ 506.90 in reimbursable costs).
