

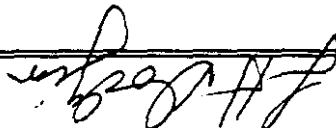

7. Prohibitions: The permittee shall restrict the types and amounts of liquids disposed of according to MAC 444.693. The permittee is prohibited from accepting the following wastes: Hazardous waste, as defined by State and Federal Regulations. Sewage sludge and septic tank pumpings, friable asbestos, hydrocarbon-contaminated soils and refrigerators containing freon and other freon containing devices.								
8. The following documents, as submitted by Eureka County and approved by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection, also describe and/or restrict the operation of this disposal site: (a) Plan of Operations (b) Report of Design (c) Plan for Closure (d) Plan for Postclosure Care								
9. The following conditions are also incorporated as a part of this permit: (a) Compliance with NRS 444.440 through 444.620, inclusive, and NAC 444.570 through 444.7499. (b) Special waste disposal conditions: Quantities of waste tires greater than ten (10) shall be either (a) buried with C&D waste that is disposed of separate from municipal solid waste, or, if codisposed with municipal solid waste, (b) placed in a single layer and covered with a compacted layer of cover material at least as thick as the layer of tires. (c) Complete documentation of financial assurance in compliance with NAC 444.685 to NAC 444.689, inclusive, shall be entered into the operating records of the site by April 9, 1997. The Division shall be notified when the documentation has been placed in the record. (d) NDEP will determine whether ground water monitoring, moisture monitoring in the vadose zone, or no monitoring program is required at the site following a regulatory determination by the State Environmental Commission on September 10th, 1996 [Note: in March 1996 federal Public Law 104-119 was signed which exempts small arid landfills from ground water monitoring. NDEP is petitioning the State Environmental Commission to change the Nevada Solid Waste Regulations to provide this exemption in Nevada while allowing NDEP to require ground water or vadose zone monitoring on a site specific basis. Therefore, a decision on monitoring requirements at this site will be deferred until the regulatory issue has been settled. This permit may be modified at that time.]

10. Findings:

The permittee must inform the Division of any deviation from or change in the information in the application which may affect the permittee's ability to comply with applicable regulations or conditions of the permit. This permit may be revoked if written notice is given by the Division and compliance with permit conditions and applicable statutes and regulations is not maintained.

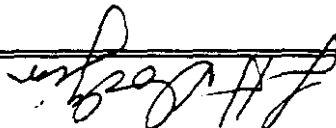
