Declaration of Homestead
E. C. Phillips

I E. C. Phillips of Eureka Eureka County state of Nevada, am a married man and the head of a family and at the time of making this declaration residing with my said family upon the premises described as follows to wit That certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in Eureka Eureka County state

of Nevada on the Eastern side of Spring street and near the corner of Clark street in said town and known and designated on the Map of the Monroe Survey of said town as Lot No (21) two in Block (12) twelve and being 25 1/2 Twenty five feet front & one hundred 100 feet deep. That it is my intention to hold and claim the same together with the tenements and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto as a Homestead under and by virtue of the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the state of Nevada entitled an act to exempt the Homestead and other property from forced sale in certain cases Approved March 6th 1865 and other acts amendatory and supplemental thereto.
